Soon after family and friends joined together and created the **Scott Hazelcorn Children's Foundation**. Its mission is to provide help to all children in need, with an emphasis on children who lost a loved one on 9/11/01.

**Camp Haze week** continues to be a free one week sleep away camp for **up to 100** children of victims of 9/11 or have lost a parent to tragedy, ages 7-13. As in our 7 previous years, **Camp Haze** provided these children the opportunity for respite from their problems, by encouraging them to play, laugh and share and yes, sometimes, cry together.

Though Camp Haze continues to be our primary initiative, we also are sponsoring **Scotty's Room**. Our first **Scotty's Room** at the **Children's Specialized Hospital in New Brunswick, New Jersey** was dedicated during this past year. It provides a fully equipped area for visiting children to interact with their hospitalized siblings so as to minimize the short and potential long term negative effects of hospitalization on children of all ages while fostering continued growth and skill development. We also continue to fund the **9-11 Mothers and Young Children's Project of Columbia University Medical Center** supporting those mothers who were pregnant and widowed on 9/11 and their children with valuable therapeutic help in dealing with the loss

The funds raised at this year's Annual Golf Outing will help support these programs and future programs for children in need.

Our memory of Scott and his desire to help others, especially children, is and will be the driving force to continue our mission and with your help we will succeed for years to come.

**DIRECTIONS FROM GOETHALS BRIDGE:**

From Goethals Bridge, stay right and follow signs for Bayway Avenue/Elizabeth (Route #439 West). Take Bayway Avenue to traffic circle. Go half way around traffic circle and continue on Bayway (which now changes its name to South Elmora/Route #439 North).

Continue on South Elmora (Route 439 North) to the 12th traffic light (exactly 2.0 miles) and make left onto Morris Avenue (Route #82 West).

Proceed on Morris Avenue for 8 traffic lights, once again exactly 2.0 miles. You will see a Shopping Center on the right—the entrance to Club is 60 yards past the Shopping Center on the opposite side of the street.

**DIRECTIONS FROM GARDEN STATE PARKWAY:**

Garden State Parkway Southbound: Take Exit 140A, follow service road directly onto Route #22, proceed approximately 100 yards and make first right off Route #22 (Route #82 East/ Elizabeth), continue bearing right and make right onto Morris Avenue (Route #82). Entrance to Club 1/4 mile on right before traffic light.

Garden State Parkway Northbound: Take Exit 140, follow service road on to Route #82 / Elizabeth. Entrance to Club 100 yards on right before traffic light.

**DIRECTIONS FROM NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE:**

New Jersey Turnpike Southbound or Northbound: Take Exit 14 - Newark Airport, pay toll and follow signs for Route #78 West (LOCAL LANES ONLY), Take Exit #52 and follow signs onto Garden State Parkway South. Take Exit 140A, follow service road directly onto Route #22, proceed approximately 100 yards and make first right off Route #22 (Route 82 East/ Elizabeth), continue bearing right and make right onto Morris Avenue (Route #82). Entrance to Club 1/4 mile on right before traffic light.
